COURT TIME WITH THE PURCHASE OF A Koch Family Tennis Center Practice Pass

With the first 20 passes sold before May 31, 2009, the cardholder will receive a certificate for court fees at Hanscom Tennis Center to be redeemed in **October 2009**.

Family Pass: \$60.00 Gift Certificate Single Pass: \$30.00 Gift Certificate
Junior/Senior: \$25.00 Gift Certificate

Age Eligibility:

Adult: Anyone who turns 20 during the calendar year.
Juniors: 18 and under. An 18-year old junior who turns 19 at anytime during the calendar year is eligible for a junior card for the season
Seniors: 62 and over. A 61-year old who turns 62 at anytime during the calendar year is eligible for a senior card for the season.
Family: Family cards can include up to 5 players living in the same household. Family is defined as no more than 2 adults over 18 and children ages 18-and-under. Names must be given at time of card purchase, and proof of residency may be required. Additional adult household members may be included, in a family pass, at \$25.00 each, providing they meet all other family criteria. (Example: 2 adults, 2 children under 18, and one 21 year old adult household resident - \$195+\$25)

Fees:

The Practice pass card prices are \$195 family, \$95 Singles, \$85 Junior/Senior
The cardholder's portion of the daily court fee is waived.
The fee for lights is not included in the seasonal card. (Season is May-September)
Non-cardholder playing with cardholders will pay their portion of the fees before play begins. For example, a court at noon Saturday for 1 1/2 hours of singles is \$9.00. Cardholder pays \$0 and the non-cardholder would pay \$4.50. Any non-cardholder playing with the cardholder must pay his portion of the court time beyond 1 1/2 hours.
The cardholder making the reservation is responsible for all court fees.
Cardholder must pay fees for any tournaments, programs, lessons, USTA Team tennis, all leagues public and private, etc.

Reservations:

Cardholders may schedule daily play for a one-time fee within the agreed rules.
Court time can be scheduled anytime the center is open, subject to availability; however, Koch Tennis Center leagues, programs, event and lessons have first priority. Dates are typically posted in advance.
NEW - Cardholders can make reservations one week in advance. (Example: a Wednesday court time may be reserved anytime on the prior Wednesday) In the event the court must be cancelled, please notify a Koch Center Staff immediately so the court can be made available to others.
Reservations may be made for a two (2) hour limit each day. After your reserved time, if a court is open, the cardholder may continue to play at no charge.
If court time is not available, cardholders may place their names on a waiting list.

Daily Rules & Eligibility:

The card must be presented at check-in each visit.
Cards are not transferable.
The cards may not be used for commercial instruction or lessons at Koch Tennis Center.
Cardholder intending to use more than 3 balls (as a courtesy to other players) must request, in advance, a court away from others.

Refund policy: Through May 31, 50% refund, with legitimate proven medical or other pertinent documentation. No refunds will be given after May 31. All refunds are subject to department approval.

Throughout the year, the Koch Center reserves the right to modify card rules at any time.
